Annual inspection has taken place and report received, Creative Play have supplied quotes for repairs to small defects and highlighted areas that need monitoring, but overall report is good.

Cllr. Leslie has liaised with United Utilities regarding funding options for this project and a project of road marking within the village. UU have pledged £5,000 for the entry signs and will undertake road markings and speed sign replacement where necessary once all works completed on their project.
