A) Options available from TWM are;

1. Visit site and get the existing solar panel functional again will be the usual site visit cost of £150.00 plus the cost of the new battery £63.50
2. If the above fails we could replace the faulty Solar Panel with a brand new one (12 month warranty as standard) cost for this would be £400 including new battery also with a warranty

There is still the initial site visit cost outstanding of £150 to be added to each option.

Option 1 would leave you with £363.50

Option 2 would leave you with £550.00

B) Cllrs. Sime and Wilson to remove the existing solar panel to determine the fixing mechanism and whether alternative solar panels will fit the system.
